

Privacy Policy

Introduction

Drink, Shop & Do understands that your privacy is important to you. This Privacy Policy explains in detail the types of personal data that we may collect about you when you interact with our website. Any personal data we do collect will only be used as permitted by law.

Who we are

This website is owned and operated by Drink, Shop & Do Ltd, a limited company registered in England and Wales under company number 7220572. Drink, Shop & Do Ltd is the controller and responsible for your personal data (collectively referred to as “DSD”, “we”, “us” or “our” in this privacy policy).

What information do we collect

Personal data is any information relating to an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include any data where the identity has been removed i.e. anonymous data.

We collect personal information from you so that we can offer our services as effectively as possible. We may hold information for the following purposes:

Where information is submitted by you as part of an enquiry about our services, we may collect the following information:

- First / last name
- Title
- Email address
- Phone number
- Address
- Date of Birth

Where you have signed up to receive our newsletter or blog notifications, we may collect the following information:

- First / last name
- Email address
- Date of Birth

Where you have posted a comment on a blog post on our website:

- First / last name
- Email address

We do not collect any details about your race, ethnicity, religion, political opinions, medical etc.

We do not knowingly collect data relating to children.

How do we use the information we collect

We will only use your personal data when the law allows us to in the following circumstances:

- Where we have a legitimate interest to respond to your enquiry
- Where we need to comply with any legal or statutory obligations
- Where we have your consent to send you marketing information

How long do we store your information for

Whenever we collect or process your personal data, we will only keep it for as long as is necessary for the purpose that it was collected for. At the end of that period, your data will either be completely deleted or anonymised in a non-identifiable way for statistical analysis.

- Where you contact us with an enquiry but do not engage our services, we will keep your data for 18 months since the first contact
- Where you contact us in relation to a job application we will keep your data for 18 months after the last contact with you
- Where you contact us about a partnership opportunity we will keep your data for 3 years if there has been no activity
- Where you subscribe to our newsletter or blog alerts we will keep your data for as long as you are a subscriber

Visitors to our website

Our website uses a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect data and statistics about website usage and behaviours such as what pages are visited. This information is processed in a way which does not identify anyone and we do not make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

We use MailChimp as our automation platform. Your information will be transferred to MailChimp for processing in accordance with their Privacy Policy and Terms.

Contacting us via email

We use Gsuite for business to send and receive emails. Additionally Transport Layer Security (TLS) is used to encrypt and protect email traffic in line with the government requirements. If your email service does not support TLS any emails we send or receive may not be protected in transit.

Access to your information

Under the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), you have the following rights:

- Right to access the personal data we hold about you
- Right to rectification if any personal data we hold about you is incorrect or incomplete
- Right to erasure if you'd like us to delete any personal data we hold about you
- Right to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances

- Right to data portability to have your data transmitted to another controller
- Right to object to the processing of your data in certain circumstances
